# **Blocking or reporting unauthorised transactions**

You can use Mobile Banking to block your debit card immediately to protect it from further such transactions

### **Block through Mobile Banking**

### How to block your debit card using Mobile Banking

- Login to Mobile Banking App using your 4 digit login pin.
- Click on "Debit Card Control" on bottom right side.
- Select "Hotlist/Block Debit Card".
- Enter Details "Account No.", "Debit Card No.", "Reason", "Remarks (optional)" and click on "Proceed'.

## **Block through Phone Banking**

 To report debit card /mobile banking / UPI / Aadhaar enabled Payments System (AePS) transactions not done by you, call Phone Banking on 7051510170/73 or mail us at helpdesk@jkgb.in

#### Please read instructions below before reporting

To report unauthorised transactions on Mobile Banking, phone banking officer requires:

- Customer ID
- Account number
- Transaction date
- Transaction amount
- Type of transaction e.g. NEFT/RTGS/IMPS

### To report unauthorised UPI transactions, phone banking officer requires:

- Mobile number
- Customer ID
- Account number
- Date of transaction and time
- Transaction amount

### To report unauthorised Debit Card or ATM card transactions, phone banking officer requires:

- Debit card or ATM card number
- Type of transaction e.g. online, at a store, local grocer, Cash withdrawal, etc.
- Date of transaction
- Transaction amount

In addition to reporting unauthorized electronic banking transactions to the bank, also report the incident to National Cyber Crime Helpline,

- Report the incident to National Cyber Crime Helpline Number at 1930
